



If it is necessary to cancel or postpone your inspection, please contact us as soon as possible. If applicable, CCRL is required to notify the accreditation body of the cancellation or postponement of the onsite inspection.

Laboratories that cancel or postpone their inspection within 20 calendar days of the start date of the inspection will be invoiced for the 20% of the estimated cost of the inspection or \$550, whichever is greater. Laboratories that cancel or postpone their inspection within 7 calendar days of the start date of the inspection will be invoiced for 40% of the estimated cost of the inspection or \$1,100, whichever is greater.

In addition, for a cancelled onsite inspection, the laboratory will be assessed the out of sequence inspection fee along with extraordinary travel expenses (which includes airfare, rental car and CCRL inspection equipment shipping) for your next onsite inspection within the current tour. Due to the backlog of onsite inspection requests caused by the pandemic, an extended period could pass until CCRL is able to reschedule a cancelled or postponed onsite inspection as a postponed or cancelled onsite inspection will be moved to the back of the waiting list.
